## A Guide to Patient Services

Yeovil District Hospital NHS Foundation Trust has a specialist Breast Care Team. This team sees newly diagnosed and follow-up cases of breast cancer as well as people who have benign breast conditions. You may not necessarily see the consultant, but you will see a doctor who specialises in breast disease.

An appointment has been made for you on:

a member of the Breast Care Team will contact you to confirm this appointment.

If you have been referred from Breast Screening for results, you will probably find it very comforting to bring someone with you when you attend.

The Breast Clinic takes place every week on Wednesday in the Outpatients Department, which is situated on Level 3 of the Main Hospital.

## **The general procedure will be as follows:**

In the clinic you will be seen by one of the specialist doctors and a Breast Care Nurse who will talk to you about your test results. The Doctor will then examine you. This will involve examining both breasts and the area under the arms.

If you require treatment based on the results of your breast investigations, the Doctor and Breast Care Nurse will talk to you about this.

The type of treatment will depend on the results of your tests. If there is a diagnosis of breast cancer, treatments including surgery, radiotherapy and medical therapy for cancer may be discussed and you will receive written information about the diagnosis and treatments.

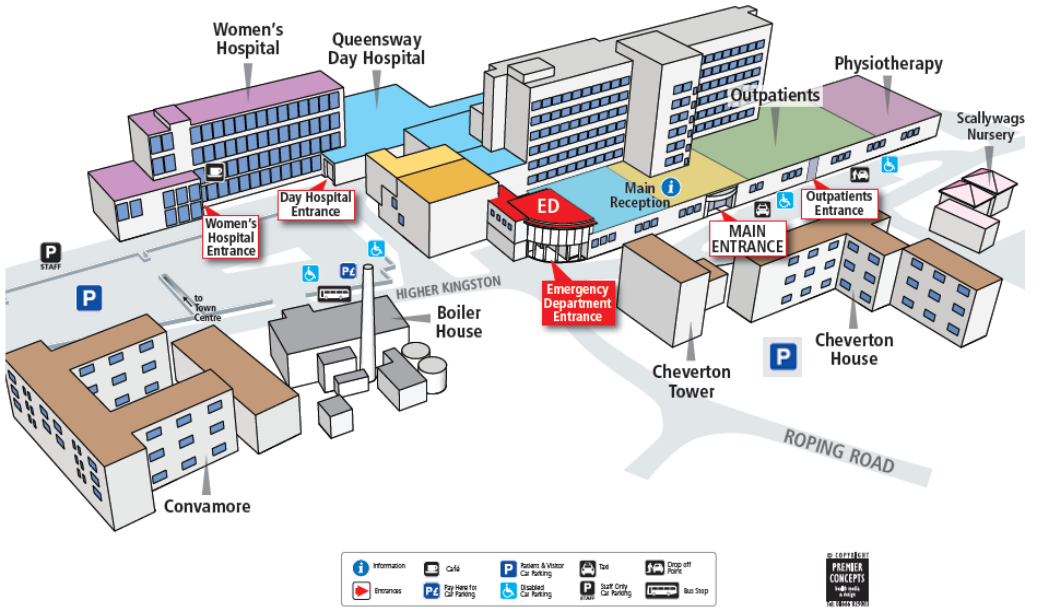

## Finding the clinic

The Breast Clinic takes place in the Outpatients Department, which is situated on Level 3 of the Main Hospital. The main entrance to the hospital is located on Level 3.

The money raised from the car park is used to fund its maintenance, for hospital security and patient care. Parking is limited so please ensure you allow plenty of time before your appointment.
